MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL:

- 1. My name is Hohepa Taipavi Paati. I an currently a student at the Waikato Institute of Technology. I am a trustee of the Taumatanui o te Maru o Paca and I also work for the Ngati Paca Whanay Trust.
- 2. I am the descendant of Wi Hoete.
- 3. Wi Hoete was a signatory to the Treaty of Waitzingi for and on behalf of Ngati Proa.
- 4. My tupuna Wi Hoete on several occasions made clear his position and the position of Ngati Paca in relation to the confiscations at East Waivoa.
- 5. It is my beleif that Wi Hoete's submissions were not given proper consideration by The Crown as is the crown's obligation under the Treaty of Waitingi.
- 6. I want to maintain that his grievances are still relevant today and relative to the welfare and well being of Agati Paca.
- 7. I maintain that the confiscations and subsequent compensations made were by no means fair, just or final.
